Grow Grant Cycle

The Grassroots Fund Grow grantmaking cycle is steeped in a participatory process that intentionally and explicitly involves the New England community in decisionmaking about grant funding. Because of this there are multiple steps that take place between grants being submitted by community groups and final decisions being communicated. In general, this process takes approximately three months. Below you'll find a rough approximation of the steps and time that goes into the Grow grantmaking cycle.

1.) Grow Grant applications close

One week

5.) Final decisions are communicated to applicants

2.) Community Grant
Readers are trained and
begin reviewing
applications

4.) Grassroots Fund
Grantmaking Committee
reviews notes and
applications and makes
final funding decision

3.) Grassroots Fund staff review Community Grant Readers notes and conduct 1-1 calls with applicants






Fall 2023 Grow applicants requested a total of \$350,000. After our participatory process, \$258,824 was allocated to community groups.






STATES (FUNDED GROUPS)




ISSUE AREA




BUDGET SIZE



TAX STATUS






