### Stage 1: Identify Desired Results

#### Established Goals

1. Understand how to launch grassroots expressions of land & water work;
2. Understand how grassroots land & water projects can get to root causes;
3. Understand how grassroots work furthers regional land & water strategies;
4. Understand how to measure impact of land & water efforts; and
5. Understand how land & water work can create co-benefits across other (issue) areas.

#### Enduring Understandings

##### *Participants will understand ...*

- A. How to determine first steps towards land & water organizing;
- B. How to develop efforts to start addressing root causes;
- C. How grassroots projects contribute to regional land & water impact(s);
- D. How to develop a basic evaluation strategy to assess impacts; and
- E. How to prioritize co-benefits with other (issue) area projects/campaigns.

#### Essential Questions

##### *Participants will seek deeper understanding through considering...*

- A. Who has access to conserved land and water?
- B. How can we ensure equitable access to grassroots land & water projects?
- C. How do we tell the history of our local land and water? *Are we telling its history?*

##### *As a result of this track, participants will be able to...*

1. Determine first steps towards land & water organizing;
2. Develop efforts to start addressing root causes;
3. Develop a basic evaluation strategy to assess impacts; and
4. Identify and prioritize co-benefits with other (issue) area projects/campaigns.
